### **Planned Power Outage at St. John's International Airport**

**St. John's, NL, Tuesday, September 22, 2015** – A planned power outage is scheduled to occur at St. John's International Airport today, September 22, from 11:00 p.m. until 3:00 a.m., Wednesday, September 23.

The outage is to facilitate the installation of a new electrical system in the Airport Terminal Building.

Certain facilities within the terminal building will be affected, however, there will be minimal to no impacts on flight operations and at no point in time is the airfield lighting or navigational systems affected by this outage.

***St. John's International Airport Authority** is a private, not-for-profit organization with the mandate to provide the region with a safe, cost-efficient transportation facility that is a catalyst for economic growth. Under the provisions of a long-term Ground Lease with the Federal Government of Canada, the Airport Authority is responsible for the airport's operations on behalf of the community it serves.*
