The award recognizes St. John's International Airport Authority for its leadership in a number of areas. Here are some reasons why the Airport Authority was selected one of Atlantic Canada's top employers:

- In addition to in-house job training initiatives, St. John's International Airport Authority offers employees tuition subsidies for courses related and not directly related to their position
- St. John's International Airport Authority provides excellent family-friendly benefits, including maternity and parental leave top-up for mothers (to 93 per cent of salary for up to 50 weeks) and parental top-up for fathers and adoptive parents (to 93 per cent of salary for up to 35 weeks)
- St. John's International Airport Authority encourages employees to keep fit with free memberships to an onsite fitness facility that's open 24 hours, seven days a week
