### **St. John's International Airport Authority Implementing New Health and Safety Measures**

**New measures coming into effect 00:00 hrs Friday, July 3.**

The St. John's International Airport Authority announced today that it will implement new health and safety measures effective at the start of Friday, July 3.

Beginning tomorrow, masks will be mandatory at all times for everyone in the Airport Terminal Building. This includes passengers and airport workers.

There will also be limited access to the terminal building. The terminal building will be open to passengers and airport workers only. If you are picking up or dropping off a passenger, please wait outside. Exceptions to both measures can be made in special circumstances.

With the province opening up to the Atlantic Bubble, the new health and safety measures will contribute to a safe airport environment for passengers, visitors and workers.
