Media Statement: Airport Terminal Building to Re-Open to the Public at 5 p.m.

ST. JOHN'S, NL – The Airport community has dealt with a lot of moving parts in the past 36 hours, but thanks to the ongoing efforts, St. John's International Airport remains on schedule to open to the public at 5 p.m., today, Sunday March 26th, 2023. Flight operations will resume at 7 p.m. this evening.

Remediation and operation teams continue to work tirelessly due to an isolated fire on the second floor of the Airport late Friday evening, March 24th. The affected area is cordoned off and all systems will be ready to accept the travelling public.

Passengers are advised to continue to work with their airline for travel arrangements and logistics. We again apologize for the inconveniences presented by this unprecedented incident.
