## Media Statement: Airport Terminal Building Re-Opened to the Public

ST. JOHN'S, NL – St. John's International Airport re-opened, as scheduled, at 5 p.m., March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2023, following a recent localized fire in the terminal. Flight operations are set to commence at 7 p.m.

All operations, including check-in, pre-board screening and baggage handling are open and running smoothly. Select concessionaires will be open to serve travellers this evening.

Throughout the closure, GardaWorld secured the building and prior to re-opening, the Canadian Air Transport Security Authority (CATSA) successfully completed a security sweep of all sterile areas.

The Airport Authority thanks the St. John's Regional Fire Department, Royal Newfoundland Constabulary, restoration team, Airport staff, and all other Airport partners for the critically important work required to re-open our doors.

Again, we apologize for the inconveniences created and look forward to welcoming back our travelling public.
