**Media Statement: Airport Terminal Building Closed**

ST. JOHN'S, NL – On Friday, March 24<sup>th</sup> at approximately 11:30 p.m., the main terminal building at St. John's International Airport was evacuated due to a fire in a localized area on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of the terminal. St. John's International Airport Emergency responders and St. John's Regional Fire Department responded to the incident.

Due to the safe and timely actions of our Airport personnel and partners, the fire has been confined to a specific area and no injuries have occurred. We sincerely thank our Airport community for their efforts.

At this time, the terminal building is closed to the public. We are assessing the affected area and will share more information as it becomes available.

Passengers are asked to please check with their airline before heading to the airport on Saturday, March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2023.
