Media Statement: Update on Airport Terminal Building Operations

ST. JOHN'S, NL – Operations at St. John's International Airport are set to resume Sunday evening, March 26th, 2023. The terminal building is set to open to the public at 5pm and operations are set to resume at 7pm.

St. John's International Airport Authority continues to work with St. John's Regional Fire Department, the Royal Newfoundland Constabulary, a building restoration team, and our airport partners due to a significant event on late Friday evening, March 24th, 2023. At that time, the main terminal building was evacuated due to a fire on the second floor of the building.

Remediation and operation teams continue to work around the clock. Passengers are advised to continue to check with their airline to confirm flight status. Flight information is also available at www.stjohnsairport.com.

The St. John's International Airport Authority expresses sincere gratitude to all partners who have worked throughout the weekend to safely re-open the terminal building. Updates will be provided throughout the day as required.
