- Diagnose and provide solutions to work stations, file servers, communication servers, routers, switches, firewalls, and other connectivity related equipment;
- Apply operating system updates, patches, and configuration changes;
- Implement, monitor and test back-up systems;
- Analyze system logs and identify potential issues.
